Boundless Learning Initiative is a parent led session(s) which could help enhance students' knowledge in various fields. This programme kick started in November 2019. The first series of sessions were conducted by Dr. Priya Naik, PSA for FMR. She conducted 3 sessions targeting specific age groups.

Sessions were conducted for the Montessori section upto years 6 with age relevant topics which included :



Importance of Teeth, Brushing Techniques, ill effects of habits like thumb sucking and nail biting and foods that promote and harm oral health, the harmful effects of carbonated(aerated) drinks on teeth, the harmful effects of Smoking, E Cigarettes and second hand vapor and various Orthodontic problems that children face at ages 10,11 and 12. A thorough Oral Health Checkup followed where children with zero

cavities and good oral hygiene were rewarded with a gold star. They were also given a dental report to carry home to their Parents.

Year 3 Mathematics: The students analysing and comparing 3D shapes based on measurable attributes. A student pointing to shapes that have no sides and edges.






Library session- Extended work:






Mathematics- Year 1 students representing two digit numbers using beads on an abacus.


